# Comparison with last year

- Less of a focus on showing a system and less focus on discussing “what is software visualization”

# Emerging themes this year

- More emphasis on:
  - Who are the stakeholders (programmers, testers, architects, managers, trainees/trainers)
  - What tasks does the visualization support
    - More focus on evolution
    - Understanding versus communication
  - Barriers to adoption
    - Usability of tools
    - Expertise required
    - “seamless integration” with existing tools

# Emerging themes cont.

- Other observations
  - Diversity of tools
  - Static vs dynamic information
  - Customization issues
- Remaining challenges
  - 3D – when is it useful?
  - Should we have more roundtrip visualization?
  - Evaluation – how do we? Benchmarks?
